**Scripture Reading:** Matthew 14:25-31 KJV

**Scripture Focus:** *"If it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water"*-Matthew 14:28 KJV  
*"And He said, Come"*-Matthew 14:29 KJV

As Peter was travelling with a few of his fellow disciples on the sea, the Bible tells us that they saw a man who appeared to be walking on waters. In a moment which seemed to be defined by great amazement, it turned out that the man on the water was Jesus himself. It is through the process of this story that we see a glimpse of confounded faith as the disciples seemed to be challenged by the foundations of their intellectual, physical and spiritual understandings.

While they tried to embrace this experience of the known dry land miracle working Jesus now walking on the waters, they were also altogether frightened as they had never conceived such a reality.

In the midst of this experience however, Peter marshaled the courage to take a radical approach. He said, 'Lord if it be you, ask me to come'. In essence, Peter dared to do just like Jesus! Here we see the activation of boldness as it is one key ingredient of swift Kingdom advancement. Peter's boldness commanded an open door answer as Jesus replied, "come", a reality that stood in clear contrast to the fear exhibited by the other disciples who remained on the boat.

As the all knowing God on earth, Jesus must have known that walking on waters in the middle of the night would have caused His disciples to lose their composure. Yet, He did it. Why?...[more](#)
