Now given the many opinions and positions surrounding finance whether in the world at large or in the church; I thought it prudent to share a few biblical thoughts on the subject with you. Here are three points that I would like you to give careful consideration to and the Lord give you understanding in all things:

Money is a Vein - *"Surely there is a vein for the silver, and a place for gold where they fine it" (Job 28:1)*. In the Scriptures the idea of a vein speaks of a level or realm. This is a place where something has been assigned to flourish. In simple terms a vein is where things flow. Money is no different. There is a legitimate money level in life. You and I must tap into this level of existence on our way to the greatest level, that of true riches. The best way to tap into this vein is first to enquire of God and then to ensure that our hearts are pure.

Money is a Voice - *"...money answereth all things" (Ecclesiastes 10:19)*. The main point of this text is that things in this life have been assigned to address areas of life. For instance the first portion of this text speaks of a feast which has been assigned to speak to the area of laughter and wine which speaks to merriment. Money likewise has been given a voice to speak in the area of our bills and obligations. Without this voice you and I will be rendered speechless and at the mercy of creditors in critical areas of life.

Money is a Vehicle - Lastly, it is important that we never regard money as an end in and of itself. Rather, money is to be viewed as a vehicle to get us to a greater end. Your finances is the vehicle through which you will be able to bless others, help the needy, take care of your family, advance the Kingdom of God and ultimately make the world a better place.

As you have heard me say on many occasions, this present time is the greatest moment in human history. You, your gifts and your finances have been summoned for such a time as this. Do not let the enemy rob you in the area of your finance. Let your finance be one of the many fences that God has designed for your safety, (Ecclesiastes 7:12).

As always my prayer for you is that you will be whole in spirit, soul and body; and that the increase of God will be experienced in every area of your life, in the name of Jesus Christ, Amen!

you build a safety net. In other words, if you cast your bread in the river you feed fish, and in times of need they shall feed you. As Jesus fed multitudes, He also walked confidently among people and never lacked anything.

The good news is that credit history is not hard to build/rebuild at all. Every day God gives us the opportunity to learn with Him. In the Kingdom, financial breakthrough starts in the spirit. One cannot access God favor if they cannot nurture relationship with Him through holistic first fruits, tithes and offerings. How you treat the Most Important Person in your life will always be a template of how you treat the least and in turn what will consistently return to you.

The reason why your boss loves your coworker is because there is a set of unique traits that make him/her so positively unique and indispensable to the organization. She/he has a style that the board of directors can't do without. Were they born with it? Maybe, maybe not. The good news is that you too can develop your own style and carve out a sought after brand. How can you get there? Here are four basic points to be aware of:

1-Know who you are: Study yourself so that you become well versed about the best subject in the universe: you. 3-Come out of your corner office: Make sure that you become visible. Create a buzz around you. Give people an opportunity to consistently experience you on this new level. You must become the first and prime example for people when referring to the style you represent.

4-Wear you: finally, remember to be you all the time. It takes repetition before a brand becomes established in people's minds. If it means wearing that bow tie everyday and everywhere, never leave home without it.

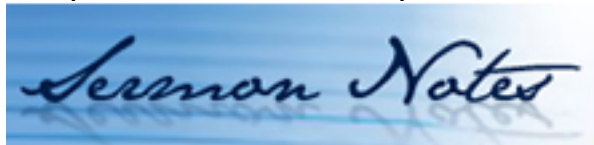
