Welcome to November, where our focus will be Finances. Amidst the global economic turmoil, especially in our financial and housing markets, allow me to speak a brief word to you concerning God's purpose for money and the role that money is to play in the advancement of His great and global kingdom.



Money is A Voice - The Bible teaches that money provides an answer to life's affairs. The text points to the fact that money has a voice and is intended to speak to economic matters in life. The lack of finance will cause us not to have a societal voice (especially in the marketplace) and God's people are never to be without a voice. As an answer we must embrace the fact that money provides a critical response to anthropological issues such as ministry, poverty, medicine, shelter and human welfare, (Ecclesiastes 10:19).

Money is A Vehicle - Money is also to be viewed as a vehicle taking us to a greater end and never as an end in itself. Those who see money as an end generally end up worshipping or falling in love with it. Those who see money as a means to an end generally use it to promote greater good in the world. In the parable of the talents, one can argue that Jesus should and could have given the last servant a break.
